Addressing Anxiety in Young Learners: A Teacher's Guide to Recognizing Needs

In this training, educators will learn how to identify and address anxiety among young children. It is important to distinguish between fear, stress, and anxiety. In addition, we will recognize warning signs of anxiety, identify struggling with anxiety, reduce and manage anxiety on an individual basis, and partner with parents/caregivers to bridge the gap between school and home.

An Introduction to the Environment Rating Scales (including the ECERS-3)

This training is for center-based programs and family child care providers and offers an overview of the Environment Rating Scales. The Environment Rating Scales are user-friendly assessment tools that measure the quality of the learning environment for infants through schoolage children. After completing this training, participants will be able to use the tool(s) for program self-assessment and improvement planning. Priority registration will be given to those who have not yet met their 50% requirement for ExceleRate and will be determined in conjunction with the Quality Specialist.

Connecting the Dots: Why Do I Respond the Way I Do?

In this training, we will take a deeper look at how our caregiving style is connected to our teaching style and how it influences our ability to foster meaningful connections with children in our care. The New Professional's Quick Start Guide to the CCR&R System
